Patient Financial Assistance and Support

In 2020, support from The William Brian Moody Foundation was critical in helping us to assist 215 men and women battling cancer. Despite the pandemic, cancer treatment has not stopped. The unprecedented financial pressures caused by the pandemic took their toll on our patients and their families. We are very grateful to your family and The William Brian Moody Foundation for enabling us to alleviate the financial stressors and allowing our patients to focus on their treatment.

In 2020:

- 127 patients received gas cards
- 10 patients received rent or mortgage assistance
- 61 patients received assistance with overdue utility bills
- 75 grocery, Walmart, and meal cards were given
- 87 patients received assistance with their medications

The Lives You've Touched

- A mother, in the middle of her own cancer diagnosis, was focused on her 13-year-old daughter who was also in the hospital with a critical illness. Your support helped this mother and daughter with rent and utilities in their moment of greatest need.
- A gentleman who was working a minimum-wage job throughout his cancer treatment and needed assistance with transportation to and from his appointments. He had to travel more than 50 miles each way for his care. Because of you, we were able to provide him with gas cards to ensure he wouldn't have to choose between paying for gas and getting access to treatment.
- A healthcare professional, who had to take six months of leave due to her cancer treatment, and whose husband lost his job and income due to COVID-19. Your support helped them with rent and utilities until they could get back on their feet.
- A mother who was trying to juggle the challenges of helping her child adjust to virtual learning during the pandemic, while facing her own battle with cancer. Your support helped to ensure her child had access to internet and could stay enrolled in virtual learning.
