GAS CARDS

9 patients received gas cards to help make transportation for treatment easier.



RENT/MORTGAGE

7 patients received help with their rent or mortgage so they could focus on treatment.



UTILITY BILLS

27 patients received assistance with overdue utility bills.



MEAL CARDS

21 patients were given grocery cards to have nutritious meals during care.



MEDICATION

87 patients received assistance with their medication prescriptions.

The Lives You've Touched

- A 65-year-old female, along with her husband and special needs son, had to stay in a hotel for a week while their home was being treated for bedbugs. With your help, she was able to continue her daily treatment without any delays.
- A 65-year-old male, and non-English speaking patient, was provided with transportation to and from treatment for five days as no other transportation options were available.
- When a 59-year-old male received an eviction notice, we were able to provide him the financial assistance he needed to keep him in his apartment and give him grocery cards until he was able to get on food stamps. We were also able to pay one month of the electric and water bills until local resources could assist. He was able to continue his treatment while staying in his home his home, thanks to the William Brian Moody Foundation.

These are just a few of the many resources that you have made possible. As our community continues to expand, your generosity will continue to impact the lives of cancer patients that walks into any of our facilities. There are not enough words to express our appreciation.
