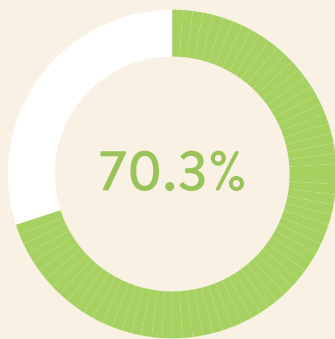

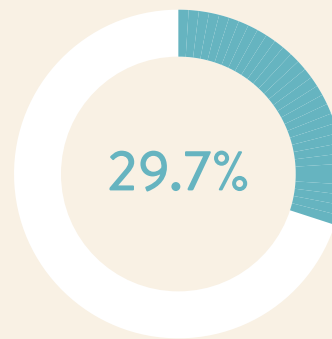

TUMOR BOARD TECHNOLOGY: \$21,805

When it comes to cancer care, looking at a patient's case from different perspectives is an essential part of deciding the best treatment approach. That is why Tumor Boards are so crucial. A Tumor Board is comprised of a group of doctors and other healthcare providers with different specialties who meet regularly to discuss cancer cases and to share knowledge. The Board's goal is to determine the best possible cancer treatment and care plan for an individual patient.

Tumor Boards are an important part of treating our patients at Roper St. Francis Healthcare. For years our physicians and administrators have utilized paper records and manual data entering with good outcomes. However, technology can improve this process significantly. A new software system from EPIC will allow Roper St. Francis to digitalize and centralize the Tumor Board process. Everyone involved with an individual cancer patient can quickly see all the relevant information. The Tumor Board will still get together, but if a team member misses a meeting, they can log in to this technology to immediately stay up to date with a patient's information.

Results from other healthcare systems show that this software can reduce the time it takes to prepare for and present a multidisciplinary cancer case by over 60%, allowing more cases to be reviewed every week. This technology will allow more patients to receive the comprehensive cancer care they need and get it more quickly.



UPDATING THE INFUSION SUITE AT WEST ASHLEY CANCER CENTER: \$9,195

The remainder of your gift this year is being used to make some much-needed improvements to our Infusion Suite at the West Ashley Cancer Center. Your funds will be applied to several improvements there, including:

- The purchase of 28 new infusion chairs – both patient recliners, and seating stools for guests and staff;
- Replacing the floors in the Infusion Suite;
- Updated furniture for the 1st floor including the Lobby, Healing Boutique and Infusion Suite;
- Additional seating for the Gerry King Memorial Garden. A table with seats and an umbrella so patients and their families can enjoy the garden and soak up some sunshine while receiving treatment

Such improvements are often not possible for a not-for-profit healthcare system, but we strongly believe that a refreshed and serene space can make all the difference for a patient during their healing journey. Thank you for allowing us to use your donations to touch as many lives as possible.
